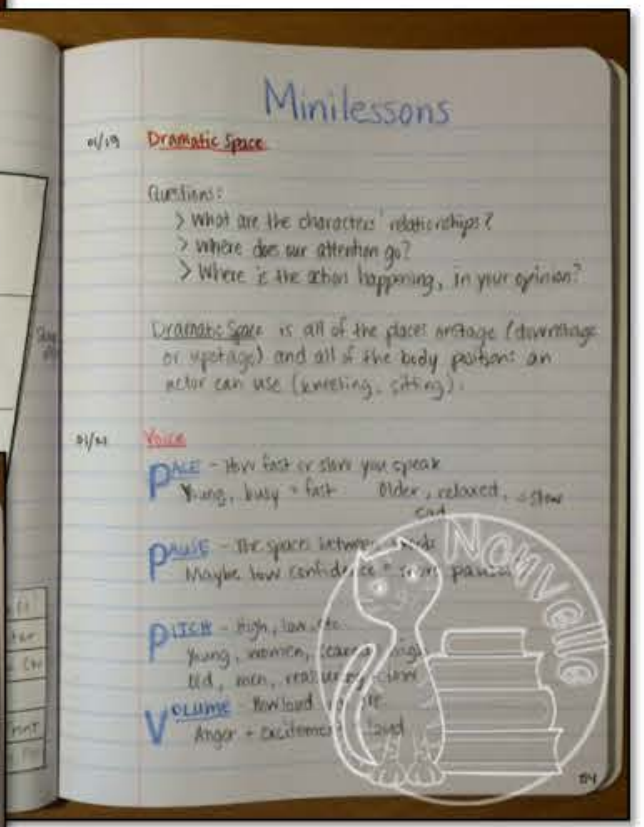
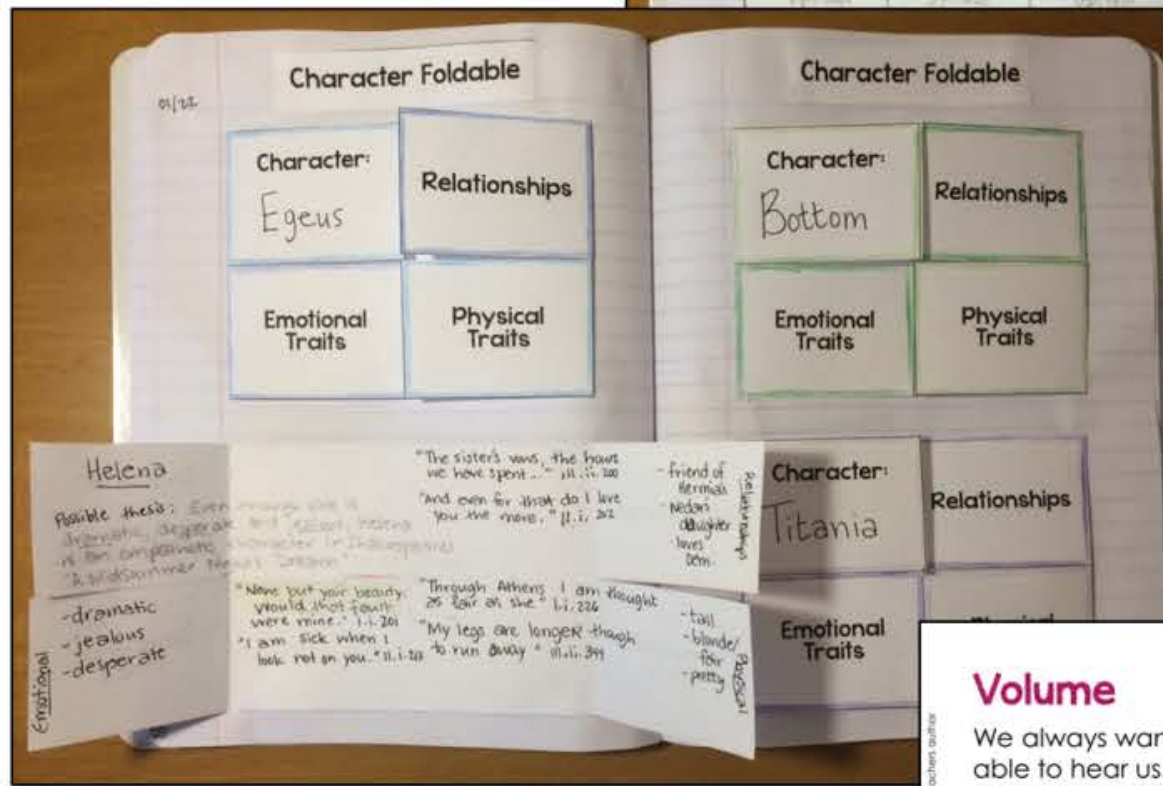
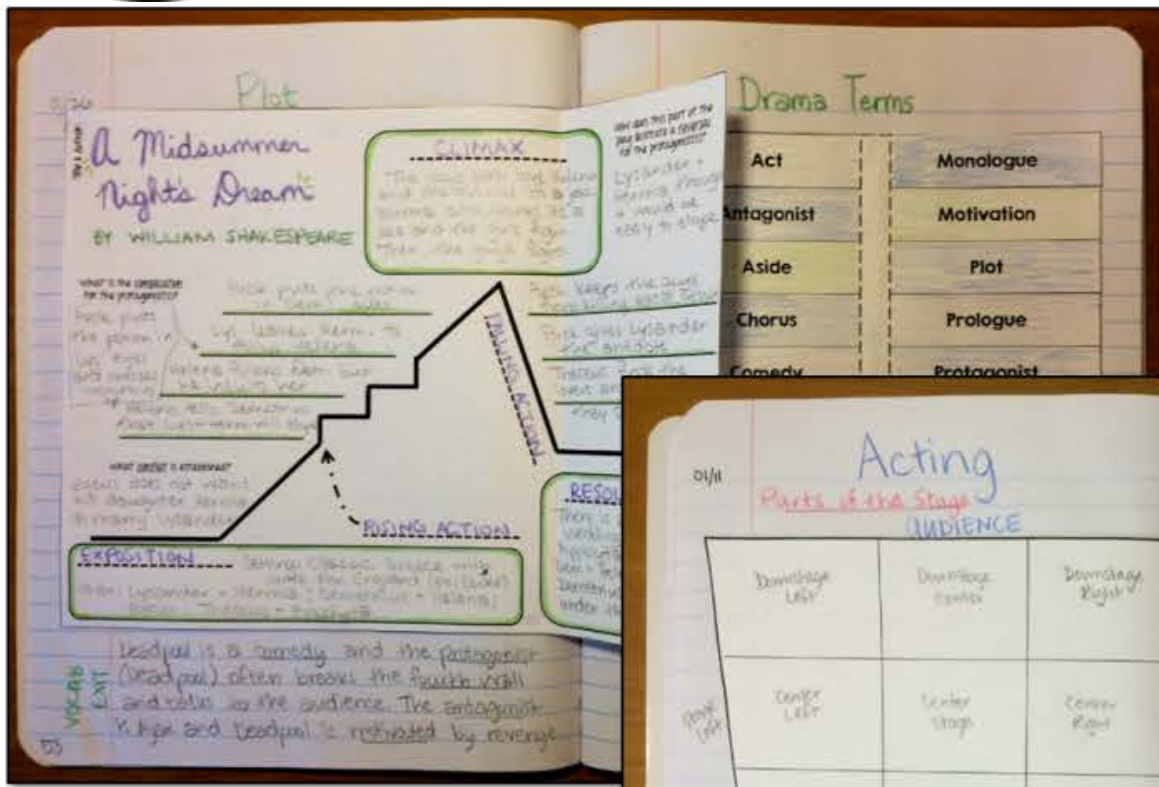

We always want the audience to be able to hear us. This is why it's important to learn to be able to control our volume.

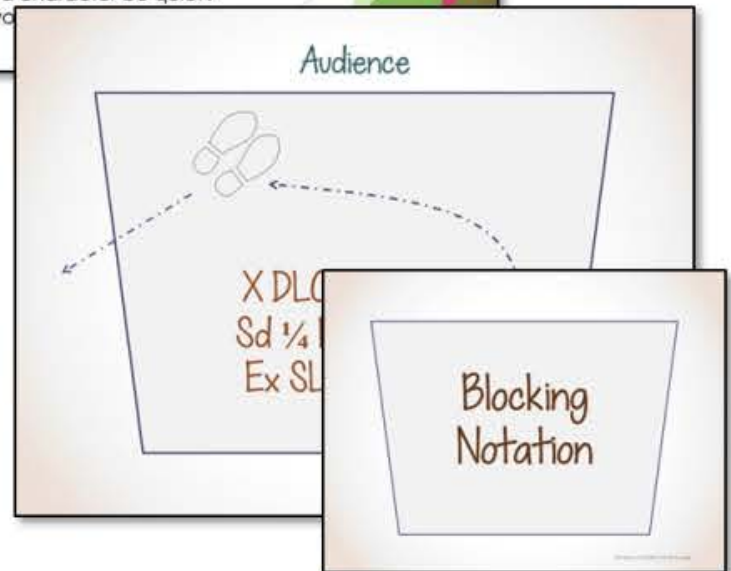
Volume can also reveal information about a character.

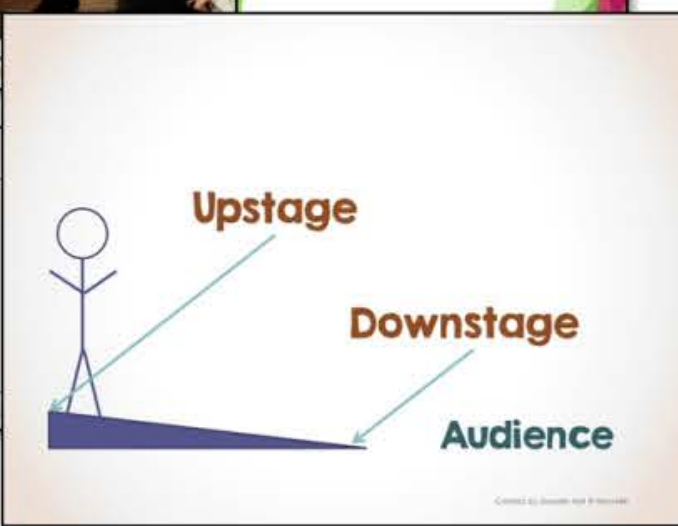

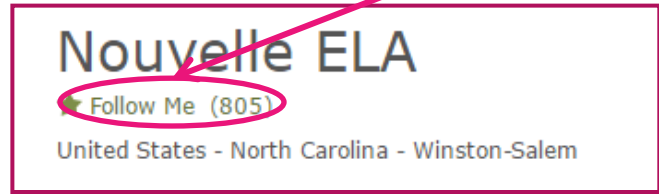
