Through samples of blood, saliva, and urine, scientists studied the effects of long-term space travel on humans (Than). Not all studies were positive. In fact, some were horrific. In the early 1900's, scientists experimented on twins to further the study of eugenics, selective human breeding. Eugenic forced those with "superior" traits to reproduce and forbade those with "less desirable" tr from doing so. Oftentimes, victims were sterilized against their will. Eugenicists hoped that studies proved that "superior" traits were hereditary to justify their beliefs.


The most well-known example of this is Adolf Hitler, who believed blonde-haired, blue-ey people were superior to other groups. He persecuted and murdered Jewish people, ethnic minorities, the mentally ill, homosexuals, and others. 




